| SUBJECT: | Helicopter Operations |

This memo covers helicopter operations at BUMC Tucson for the month of June. There were 76 medical flights during June, as compared to 112 in May and 100 a year ago.

There were five observed violations of the "no-fly zone" in June. Three of the violations were attributed to high winds by the pilots. One was a pilot new to the area and unfamiliar with the pad. Officers spoke to that pilot and his departure was correct. One of the above mentioned flights resulted in a report from our neighbors.

There were five other reports from our neighbors. In those instances, the officer on the pad observed the flight to be within acceptable limits.
