SUBJECT: Helicopter Operations

This memo covers helicopter operations at BUMC Tucson for the month of September. There were 98 medical flights during September, as compared to 103 in August and 91 a year ago.

There were five observed violations of the “no-fly zone” in September. In all five instances, the pilot stated that he had violated due to wind conditions or other safety issues. Four of the five observed violations also resulted in reports from our neighbors.

There were six other reports from our neighbors. In those instances, the officer on the pad observed the flight involved to be within acceptable limits.
