SUBJECT: Helicopter Operations

This memo covers helicopter operations at BUMC Tucson for the month of April. There were 121 medical flights during April, as compared to 113 in March and 122 a year ago.

There were nine observed violations of the “no-fly zone” in April. Three of the violations were attributed to high winds by the pilots. Several of the remaining violations occurred when Blackhawk copters were conducting “touch and go” training flights for their pilots. Six of the above mentioned flights resulted in reports from our neighbors.

There were five other reports from our neighbors. In those instances, the officer on the pad observed the flight to be within acceptable limits.
